

BAHAMAS ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARD SCHOLARS (BESS) PROGRAMME

The BESS program is a unique opportunity for graduating high school students in The Bahamas who have a keen interest in the environment and want to learn more as they transition from high school to university studies. Successful applicants will pursue a 14-week academic semester at The Island School in South Eleuthera and enroll in a four-month paid internship at BREEF. Upon completion of high school, students can use BESS as a gap year experience before pursuing further studies. Students accepted to the BESS programme will complete either:

A: The Island School Fall Semester (Aug 31– Dec 9, 2020) and Spring Internship (Jan 25- May 16, 2021)

OR

B: Fall Internship (Aug 31 – Dec 16, 2020) and The Island School Spring Semester (Feb 1– May 12, 2021)

11. Completed application for financial aid
12. Applicants should be 15-18 years of age
13. Minimum Cumulative GPA – 2.50

BESS Scholarships

Tuition for the Island School 14-week semester is \$32,800. Additional expenses including travel to and from Eleuthera, school clothing and incidentals range from \$1000 - \$1500. The BESS admission process is based on merit and potential. Ability to pay does **not** play any role in the selection process. **Full and partial scholarships are available for selected applicants.**

All BESS Scholars will receive a stipend of \$500 per month during the four-month internship period. For students living at their internship site, \$250/month will be deducted to cover room and board expenses incurred by the hosting institution.
